Exhibitors are responsible for supplying feed and need to clean, feed and care for their birds. Entry Fee 75¢ per lot entered. Pre-registration by July 25. Entry Day is August 6, 8:00 am -Noon

#### General Rules

1. Standard breeds and hybrid poultry may be exhibited.
2. Breeding poultry will be judged on breed characteristics using the American Standards of Perfection.
3. Exhibition of livestock in Minnesota requirements on page 79 will be followed.
4. Birds which are diseased or unfit for competition will not be entered.
5. Entries taken at east end of Poultry Barn on Thursday morning.
6. Removing birds prior to release time will forfeit any premiums earned.
7. Chores are owner's responsibility unless other arrangements are made.

Ribbons in 1st-8th place, Champion and Reserve Champion in each class.

#### DEPARTMENT 240 **BREEDING CHICKENS - CLASS 1**

(1 male and 2 females)

A person may NOT show more than two pens per lot.

#### Lot

1. American (Rhode Islands, Jersey Giants, Plymouth Rocks, etc.)
2. Asiatic (Cochins, Langshans, Brahams, etc.)
3. English (Orpington, Cornish, Australorp, etc.)
4. Mediterranean (Buttercups, Minorcas, Leghorns, Spanish, etc.)
5. Continental (Lakenvelder, Hamburg, Polish, etc.)
6. All Other Standard Breeds
7. Bantams, Feather Legged
8. Bantams, All Other Variety

#### **BREEDING POULTRY - CLASS 2** **(other than chickens)**

(1 male and 2 females)

A person may NOT show more than two pens per lot.

#### Lot

1. Ducks
2. Geese
3. Turkeys

#### **BREEDING MALES - CLASS 3**

A person may NOT show more than two pens per lot.

#### Lot

1. Breeding Rooster (1 rooster)
2. Breeding Drake (1 drake)
3. Breeding Gander (1 gander)

#### **MARKET POULTRY - CLASS 4**

(2 males or 2 females)

A person may NOT show more than two pens per lot.

#### Lot

1. Ducks
2. Geese
3. Turkeys
4. Chickens

#### **EGG PRODUCTION - CLASS 5**

(2 pullets)

A person may NOT show more than two pens per lot.

#### Lot

1. Chickens

#### **PIGEONS - CLASS 6**

#### Lot

1. Utility - Breeding Pair
2. Utility - Young Bird
3. Fancy - Breeding Pair
4. Fancy - Young Bird
5. Flying - Breeding Pair
6. Flying - Young Bird

All must be over 1 year old and must be Banded. NO Barn Pigeons. They will be judged on the Standard.

#### **OTHER - CLASS 7**

(Pheasants, quails, guineas, etc.)

#### Lot

1. Breeding Pen, females and 1 male
2. 1 Female
3. 1 Male
